


Guidelines for consulting the Course Catalogue of University of Minho

The objective of the course is to introduce accounting as the language of business. The course introduces the core and basic concepts of accounting, with focus on the preparation and interpretation of the financial information that is useful for the decision making of different stakeholders.
- Key learning outcomes**

The student describes and applies the basic accounting concepts.

- 2nd semester 2024/25 (February 2025 - June 2025)
