## **RESULTS OF THE OPEN CALL**

Project **JAMIES 2025**

Following the application period for the **JAMIES 2025** - Erasmus ICM, KA171 project, a total of 707 applications were received:

- 685 applications IN (487 SMS / 112 STA / 86 STT)
- 22 applications OUT (1 SMS / 14 STA / 7 STT)

From the submitted applications, 382 applications were considered not eligible, as not all relevant documents were submitted.

A total of 303 applications IN were sent for evaluation of the Home and Host institutions.

A total of 21 applications OUT were sent for validation by the Portuguese Home Institutions.

The evaluation criteria used by both Home and Host institutions was the same:

- (i) Academic suitability and the relevance of the application: 0 to 8 points
- (ii) Relevance of the work/study plan: 0 to 6 points
- (iii) CV: 0 to 3 points
- (iv) English or Portuguese language knowledge: 0 to 3 points.

The Selection Committee met via Teams, on the 21<sup>st</sup> of May 2026, and did the final selection of the scholarships/grants following established criteria for selection in order to achieve the highest impact of the project, the respect for home institutions/countries' priorities, the evaluation by host institutions, the balance among partners, the creation of new cooperation opportunities and the awareness for eventual cross-cutting issues. The methodology used to produce the final proposal for selection is indicated as following:

- ✓ Respect for the mobility distribution approved by the European Commission and Portuguese National Agency;
- ✓ Balance among partner institutions regarding the number of mobility flows (*incoming* and *outgoing*);
- ✓ Balance among partners so as to achieve a strong impact of the project (a fair distribution among the sending and receiving partners);
- ✓ Evaluation by the host/home institution;

- ✓ Level of priority defined by the candidates in the application (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> option);
- ✓ Priority defined by the home institution;
- ✓ Whenever candidates presented equivalent quality, priority would be given to the candidates with no previous mobility;
- ✓ Participants with fewer opportunities (whenever candidates presented equivalent quality, priority would be given to participants from disadvantaged groups and/or with fewer opportunities).

At the end of the process, a total of **65** scholarships/grants were allocated within the 1<sup>st</sup> call of the JAMIES 2025 project, and **7** scholarships/grants were allocated within the JAMIES 2024 project.
